BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Cauline leaves pinnate, glabrous or nearly so (cf. *C. flexuosa*, which often grows with *C. hirsuta*; and despite the species name 'hirsuta'); stem axis not zig-zagged (cf. *C. flexuosa*).
