BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Characterised by the narrow, stellate–radiating or fan-shaped lobes; crowded central apothecia with a pale proper margin bounded by a thick, crenulate–striate thalline margin.

DISTRIBUTION

Kermadec Islands: (Raoul Island). **North Island**: Northland (Three Kings Islands, Radar Bush, Rakitu Island), Auckland (Rangitoto Island), South Auckland (Great Mercury Island, Red Mercury Island, Hunua Ranges). Also known from a single collection in New South Wales.

HABITAT

Mainly coastal on trees and shrubs. Often on bark of *Metrosideros* excelsa and commonly associating with the lichens *Coccocarpia* erythroxyli, Leioderma pycnophorum, Pannaria elixii, Crocodia aurata and Usnea rubicunda.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Thallus foliose lobate, \pm rosette-forming, closely attached, to 23 cm diam., corticolous. **Lobes** narrow, contiguous at margins, imbricate, coalescing centrally, \pm stellate-radiating or fan-shaped. **Upper surface** dull plumbeous-grey, smooth to uneven, faintly maculate (\times 10 lens), often with granular lobules. **Apothecia** sessile, rounded, 0.2-1 mm diam., disc red-brown, waxy or matt, flat, with a pale proper margin, bounded by a thick, crenulate-striate thalline margin. **Ascospores** ellipsoid, 11-13 \times 5-8 μ m.

Chemistry: TLC-, all reactions negative.
