Indigenous. In New Zealand known in the North Island from three locations in Northland near Herekino, from the Awhitu Peninsula, the third recently from Waimamaku in Northland and also from Little Barrier Island, Chatham and Pitt Islands.

SUBSTRATE

Terricolous and saxicolous on rock, silt, grit and clay near streams
