BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Characterised by the corticolous habit; a pale-grey to pale red-brown, areolate thallus delimited by a black, marginal prothallus and forming mosaics on smooth bark; minute, punctiform ascomata with a dark-brown disc, arranged in thread-like lines; and 5–7-septate ascospores, $25-30 \times 4-5 \mu m$.

DISTRIBUTION

North Island: Far North (Te Paki), Auckland (Piha). South Island.

Still very poorly collected.

Known also from Cuba, Socotra, Papua New Guinea, Solomon Islands, and New Caledonia.

HABITAT

Throughout, on bark of introduced, deciduous trees in parks and gardens.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Thallus olive-green to grey or pale red-brown, smooth or minutely uneven, somewhat waxy, areolate, delimited by a thin, black, uneven, marginal prothallus, often forming coalescing mosaics, corticolous, rarely saxicolous. **Lirellae** minute, innate, to very slightly raised, round to elongate 0.2-0.8 mm long and to 0.3 mm broad, often confluent or irregularly arranged or in thread-like lines, disc brown-black, immarginate, impressed. **Ascospores** elongate, 3-7-septate, $25-30 \times 4-5 \mu m$.

SUBSTRATE

Corticolous, saxicolous
