BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Two additional varieties are recognised in New Zealand and require further investigation.

DISTRIBUTION

North Island: South Island: Northland to Southland.

Known also from Scandinavia, Europe, Great Britain, Greece, East Africa, South Africa, Indonesia, Japn, United States, Mexico, Chilie and Australia.

HABITAT

Sea level to subalpine, most common in mixed rainforest and Fuscospora forests.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Thallus small to medium, 1-4 cm diam., to 1 cm deep, very swollen and much larger when moist, subcrustaceous to crustaceous or subfoliose, rounded or irregular, pulvinate to rather flattened, often \pm globular and easily loosening when moist, usually not continuous, but variously fenestrate, in parts thin, membranous and smooth, in parts markedly rugose with dense, coarse, irregular wrinkles, or rugose-folded, distinctly to \pm indistinctly lobate, dark olive-green to brownish or blackish, paler when moist, epruinose, without isidia. **Lobes** when distinct rather variable, \pm broad, flattened, imbricate and adnate, sometimes distinctly lobulate with short lobules, margin thin somewhat swollen, \pm entire. **Apothecia** numerous, dense, often crowded, rounded, flattened, sessile on thalline wrinkles, constricted at base, 0.8-2 mm diam., disc \pm plane, dark red to red-brown or pale brown, matt, smooth, epruinose, thalline margin thick, prominent, rugose or granular, persistent, or thin and not prominent and \pm disappearing, concolorous with thallus. **Ascospores** 6-8 per ascus, monostichous and imbricate or twisted, \pm straight forming a bundle, vermiform, 10-17-celled, 52-95 \times 4.5-5(-6.5) μ m.
