

Mycosphaerella sp

FAMILY

Mycosphaerellaceae, Ascomycetes

FLORA CATEGORY

Fungi – Native

DISTRIBUTION

Auckland

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Leaf spots tan coloured with a brown, raised margin, circular to irregular in shape, up to 5 mm wide, visible on both leaf surfaces. This specific fungus has not been described. However, *Mycosphaerella* species generally produce small perithecial ascomata. The ascospores are usually ellipsoidal, hyaline, and 1-septate. *Mycosphaerella* species have been connected to several anamorphic (asexual) genera.

FRUITING

Collected on one occasion in August 1990.

SUBSTRATE

Associated with a leaf spot on *Pisonia brunoniana*.
