FAMILY

Patellariaceae, Ascomycetes

FLORA CATEGORY

Fungi – Native

DISTRIBUTION

Coromandel (Little Barrier Island)

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Ascomata consist of small, saucer-shaped, flat or slightly convex apothecia, up to 1 mm diameter, black, and sessile. This specific fungus has not been described. The ascospores of *Patellaria* species are filiform-clavate, usually slightly curved, multi-septate, and hyaline.

FRUITING

Collected on one occasion in April 1988.

SUBSTRATE

On dead twigs of *Pisonia brunoniana*.
