BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Characterised by the corticolous habit; inconspicuous translucent discs; and the lack of any secondary chemistry.

DISTRIBUTION

North Island: Northland (Hokianga). **South Island:** Nelson (Mt Duppa). Originally only known from the type collection (Mt Duppa), but since found in Hokianga (Ford 2023).

HABITAT

On bark of Griselinia littoralis and Vitex lucens.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Thallus pale-fawn, thin, continuous. **Upper surface** smooth, dull, without isidia or soredia. **Apothecia** disc-like, inconspicuous, scattered, immersed, pale-grey, translucent, with a black margin, 0.2–0.4 mm diam.; disc surface epruinose, glossy. **Ascospores** 8 per ascus, irregularly 1- or 2-seriate, ellipsoidal, smooth, 33–41 × 18–22 μ m; wall 2–4 μ m thick.

Chemistry: TLC-, all reactions negative.
