BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Characterised by the corticolous habit; verruciform apothecia; small ascospores; and the presence of 4,5-dichlorolichexanthone.

DISTRIBUTION

North Island: (Cape Palliser Wellington) (Ford 2022). **South Island**: Marlborough (Chetwode Islands) (Galloway 2007).

HABITAT

On bark. Known only from the type collection and a recent collection from Cape Palliser, Wellington corticolous on *Kunzea robusta* (M. Ford 2022).

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Thallus off-white, thin, somewhat cracked, surface smooth and somewhat shining, without isidia or soredia. **Apothecia** verruciform, very flattened-hemispherical, concolorous with thallus, scattered, 0.8–1.2 mm diam.; **ostioles** conspicuous, black, 0.2–0.3 mm diam., 1 per verruca. **Ascospores** 8 per ascus, uniseriate, ellipsoidal, smooth, 30–37 × 18–20

Chemistry: K-, C-, KC-, Pd-; containing 4,5-dichlorolichexanthone.

SIMILAR TAXA

It is superficially similar to both *P. albissima* and *P. melaleucoides* but is distinguished by the number and size of the ascospores and the presence of 4,5-dichlorolichexanthone.
