Anamorph coelomycete

FLORA CATEGORY

DISTRIBUTION

Mid Canterbury

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Pycnidia on internodes of mistletoe, raised, globose, shiny black, up to 0.25 mm diameter, often aggregated. This specific fungus has not been described. The conidia of *Phyllosticta* species are usually hyaline, unicellular, with a hyaline, filiform, apical appendage. Conidia vary in shape, often being globose to broadly ellipsoidal. *Phyllosticta* species in general cause leaf spots, but may also attack fruits or young stems of plants.

FRUITING

Collected on one occasion in April 1996.

SUBSTRATE

On internodes of living *Korthalsella salicornioides*.
