Site description:

Coprosma rhamnoides

This site is an Open Space Covenant on property belonging to the de Jong family. It is the top part of a long narrow bush remnant in a stream gully running NW/SE cut down into calcareous bedrock. There is a little flat ground on the valley floor where pukatea (*Laurelia novaezelandiae*), rewarewa (*Knightia excelsa*) and black maire (*Nestegis cunninghamii*) are emergent over a subcanopy of mahoe (*Melicytus ramiflorus*) and titoki (*Alectryon excelsus*). Below this again there is a lot of kawakawa (Macropiper excelsum) and regenerating mahoe. The steep banks have stands of kanuka (Kunzea ericoides) with a patchy understory of grasses, some ferns (mainly necklace fern (*Asplenium flabellifolium*)) and scattered scrub mostly coprosma species. Of note were a couple of tawa trees (*Beilschmiedia tawa*) as this species is not common in the area.

Grasses, sedges and ferns were present in small numbers probably reflecting a past history of grazing but numbers should now recover as the stock have been removed. There was evidence of relatively recent browse but no stock were noted. Blechnum triangularifolium, which restricts itself to limestone areas, was seen growing on the stream banks just below the crib along with the only specimen of the sedge (Carex secta). There are some plantings of exotics above the crib where there is little or no native vegetation and one kauri was noted in the bush area itself. Tree ferns were represented by single specimens of two species and the most common climbers were passionvine (*Passiflora tetrandra*), native jasmine (*Parsonsia sps.*) and bush lawyer (*Rubus schmidelioides*).

The whole remnant is flanked by exotic plantations of eucalypts and pine trees. The survey took 3 hours and was thorough.
