Notes: Damaged bush favouring eat of ferns and *Dysoxylum* on rubble slopes; curious local abundance of *Rhabdothamnus*, of *Adiantum fulvum* and small *Asplenium* also on rubble slopes. Dominant on N. margin as hedge is *Melicope simpl. x ternata* & no *M. ternata* seen. In valley *Laurelia* showing particular vigour also *Podocarpus daer.* *Collospermum* *across.* *Pittosporum cornifolium* as easily accessible attractive example. J.S.
